Opening of the statue for A. den Doolaard: May 29th 2006 Ohrid!

On behalf of the Dutch Chamber of Commerce (DCC) in Macedonia, I would like to inform you about a distinguished project, which is of significant importance for you as a member/friend of the DCC, as an entrepreneur in particular, and for Macedonia tourism in general

DCC's main objective is the advancement and support of sustainable, bilateral business relations between Macedonian and Dutch companies and entrepreneurs. In a new initiative, the DCC intends to support the Macedonian efforts in developing a professional and rich tourism offer, as well as bringing more Dutch and international tourists to Macedonia.

In the past some 50.000 Dutch tourists visited Macedonia each year, and with this new initiative, it is DCC's intention to revive this once flourishing tourism industry. Several steps have been made to achieve this objective. First, strategic planning was developed with the DCC and other organizations, to approach the Dutch market.

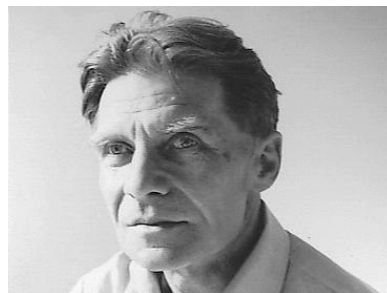
Second, marketing missions were made between local tourist agents and Dutch agents in Holland. Third, with collaboration from the MCA project, DCC helped to provide media coverage for the Macedonian travel market in the largest newspaper in Holland.

These efforts will continue with a media and cultural event that should further spark the enthusiasm of Dutch tourists, to further bring the Dutch closer to the Macedonians.

The idea is simple: in downtown Ohrid, unveil a statue of the famous Dutch writer **A. den Doolaard**, who wrote extensively about Macedonia and Ohrid and also lived in Ohrid. The event will take place from 29 May through 1 June 2006 in close cooperation with the local government of Ohrid and will be covered by numerous local, national and Dutch news media. The actual unveiling of the monument will start to take place at 7.30 pm on the 29th.
